Meeting Report: IIMM Chennai Monthly Meeting - 29th June

Topic: Geopolitics and Impact on Supply Chain and Shipping Line Challenges in Current Scenario, Date: 29th June 2024 Venue: IIMM Chennai

The monthly meeting of IIMM Chennai held on 29th June focused on the critical topic of "Geopolitics and Impact on Supply Chain and Shipping Line Challenges in the Current Scenario." The session was led by Mr. N Ramkumar, Manager at Broekman Logistics India Pvt Ltd.

The meeting commenced with a warm welcome and Hi-Tea. Mr. K Nagappan, Chairman of IIMM Chennai, initiated the event by inviting Mr. Ramkumar to the dais, presenting him with a bouquet, and delivering a welcome address. He highlighted IIMM Chennai's initiatives in enhancing knowledge sharing among Supply Chain Management (SCM) professionals through courses, seminars, and national events like Spectrum and monthly meetings. Mr. Nagappan emphasized the importance of participation in such activities to foster professional growth and collaboration within the SCM community. Mr. R Balakrishnan, Honorary Treasurer and Chairman of Monthly Meetings, introduced Mr. Ramkumar, the speaker for the day.

Presentation Highlights: Shipping is pivotal for global trade and the global economy. In recent decades, the industry has been striving for sustainable development, battling issues such as its environmental footprint, efficiency, and profitability.

Geopolitics - Impact on Supply Chain Management: Disruptions in Trade Routes: Regional conflicts or political instability can lead to the closure of trade routes, shipment delays, or increased security measures. For example, tensions in the South China Sea or the Red Sea could disrupt maritime trade. Tariffs and Trade Barriers: Heightened tensions between countries may result in tariffs or trade barriers, increasing costs for businesses due to import/export restrictions.

Sourcing Challenges: Companies heavily reliant on specific regions may face challenges if those regions experience geopolitical instability. Diversifying suppliers or exploring alternative sourcing options becomes crucial.

Logistics Delays: Increased security measures, border checks, or transportation disruptions can extend lead times for goods. Supply chain managers need contingency plans.

Currency Fluctuations: Geopolitical events can impact currency exchange rates, affecting import and export costs. Currency risk management becomes essential.

Resource Availability: Conflicts or political instability in resource-rich regions can disrupt raw material availability. Businesses must assess their dependence on critical resources.

Supply Chain Resilience: Organizations are increasingly adopting reshoring, near-shoring, and friend-shoring strategies to enhance supply chain resilience against geopolitical risks.

Geopolitics - Strategies: Providing real-time data and insights on commodities regarding market fluctuations. Recommending supply chain diversification and alternative sourcing options. Offering tailored consultancy services to help organizations adapt procurement strategies to the evolving geopolitical landscape, ensuring business continuity. Providing risk assessment reports to identify potential disruptions. Developing alternative sourcing options for critical materials. Facilitating collaboration between suppliers and buyers for smooth operations amidst geopolitical challenges.

Global Supply Chains Overview: Definition and importance. Examples of major global supply chain networks. Interplay Between Geopolitics and Supply Chains: How geopolitical events influence supply chain dynamics. Case studies and examples (e.g., trade wars, sanctions).

Specific Geopolitical Factors Impacting Supply Chains: Political instability effects. Impact of trade agreements on shipping routes and logistics. Impact on Shipping Lines: Challenges faced by shipping companies, navigation issues in international waters, and territorial disputes.

Case Study: Impact of Recent Geopolitical Events: Examples include the US-China Trade War and effects of sanctions in the Middle East.

Interesting Facts and Technological and Strategic Responses: Role of technology (e.g., blockchain, AI) in mitigating risks. Strategic responses by businesses to geopolitical uncertainties.

Future Outlook: a ship will cost over 1 billion dollars. A study by Lloyd's Register found that the global shipbuilding industry will spend almost \$100 billion on new ships over the next year or so.

A container ship engine has about 1,000 times more power than an average family car. However, large container ships only travel at 26.5 miles per hour. The world's largest container ships can carry over 21,000 TEU (20-foot equivalent unit) into ports worldwide; modern container ships can hold up to 745 million bananas. Approximately 1.5 million people are employed in the maritime sector.

97% of all shipping containers are built in China. A large cargo ship uses 150-250 tons of fuel per day, equivalent to as much fuel as 3,770 smart cars per kilometer. In a year, an average container ship travels the equivalent of 75% of the distance to and from the moon during its normal voyage across the ocean. At least 20 million containers are currently traveling across the oceans.

Recommendations: Predictions for future geopolitical trends. Recommendations for businesses to navigate challenges. The meeting concluded with a summary of key points, emphasizing the importance of adapting to geopolitical shifts in SCM. A Q&A session followed, allowing participants to engage further with Mr. Ramkumar.

To honor his contribution, Mr. Nagappan and Senior Member Mr. V Ramachandran presented a memento to Mr. Ramkumar, expressing gratitude for his insightful presentation.
