DISHA - ANNUAL SIGNATURE EVENT 27<sup>TH</sup> & 28<sup>TH</sup> **NOVEMBER 2024 AT HOTEL WESTIN, MUMBAI** 

Seventeenth edition of Disha - annual signature event of IIMM, Mumbai was held on 27th & 28th November 2024 at Hotel Westin, Mumbai, with theme being 'Supply chain Transformation - Vikas-Sheel to Viksit Bharat' and the subthemes as 'TECHNOLOGY', 'ESG Practices', 'Beyond Resilience', Talent management 'and 'Public sector reforms.'

The event started with the beats of Dhols. A large troupe of Dholis, comprising mainly of women, perfected their beats to produce rhythmic crescendo in fully packed Westin Hall, to commemorate the beginning of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary year of IIMM and to signal perfect high energy start to Disha24.

The Inaugural session started with National anthem 'Jana Gana Mana" followed by lighting of lamp at the hands of Key note speaker Mr Vijay Kasi, Partner Kearney, IIMM National President Lalit Raj Meena, Past IIMM National President Bala Iyer, IIMM 1st Vice President P.M. Biddapa, Past IIMM Sr VP J S Prakash Rao IIMM, Disha 24 Convener Satish Palekar, Mumbai Chairman Swapnil Dubey and Past IIMM Mumbai chairmen M H Varma, N D Sadri, Ganesh Apte, Surendra Deodhar, Ashok

Satish Palekar, Disha convenor & past Mumbai Branch Chairman made the opening speech and set the context by focussing on Disha 24theme and emphasised on challenges, priorities for supply chain towards 'Viksit Bharat', like adopting micro mandate, being future ready.

In his address, IIMM Mumbai Branch Chairman, Mr Swapnil Dubey spoke about IIMM and presented Mumbai branch activities and its plans. He urged participants to become IIMM member and join in its activities, stressing on its human & humane values.

Quoting Swami Vivekananda, Mr Bala Iyer in his short address outlined journey towards Viksit Bharat, through major milestones @2030, 2047 and 2060.

National President, Mr L R Meena then describing IIMM as a big family, shared about its family values, its various educational courses, international connect and about various events planned this year across India, to mark IIMM golden Jubilee. Citing logistics cost as an example, Mr Meena highlighted the responsibility shouldered by supply chain community & IIMM towards Viksit Bharat. He also took the opportunity to honour Mr Satish Palekar, Mr N.D. Sadri and Swapnil Dubey with President's medal.

Fellow IIMM member, Mr. Karthik Santhanam was felicitated by National President & Bala Iver for moving up the ladder to CEO position in corporate world which was followed with his short address to the gathering.

As keynote speaker, Mr Vijay Kasi, Partner, Kearney India shared powerful presentation 'REWIRE supply chains to win in the new world' highlighting challenges & viable solutions, in aligning with fast changing customer needs in the world under poly crisis. Using Global COO's insights and few compelling examples like 'speeds' in Pit stops of formula 4 racing, fashion garment leader Shein from China and quick commerce industry, he propounded the concept of 'supply chain rewire'. Refocus on business objective to redesigning of operating model to reimagining of technology. This concluded the Inaugural session with a Vote of Thanks by IIMM Mumbai Hon. Treasurer Arun Mehta.

At the start of technical sessions, Sushant Roy conducted pulse survey on participants expectations on Disha24. Technical Sessions on Day 1 - 27/11/24

Sitaram Kandi, Chief Human Resource Officer, Tata Motors while sharing his experiences captivated the entire audience throughout his talk on 'Motivating Energetic Teams – Handling Gen Z at workplace'. Some of his key insights while highlighting Gen X to Gen Z relations, were importance of family dinner table, 'job is part of life and not life', and emergence of reverse mentoring. He also shared on challenges faced while inducting women workers on tata motors assembly line and how they have overcome it to a stage where some of premium Tata car assembly lines are fully managed by women.

Ashwani Narang, Vice President & Business Head -Intelligent Spend and Business Network of SAP India & South Asia presented on 'Technology to support SCM'. As per him, focus on recent technology & AI, cost savings lead by ESG Talent management are some of the thrust areas, and with suppliers are expected to do most part of administrative work.

Next Satish Palekar succinctly expounded on entire spectrum of energy transition scenario, within India as well as globally, describing many push &pull levers for transition. Using nicely designed slides, Mr Palekar explained all aspects of energy transition like power capacities of various sustainable power generation types, inadequacies of energy storage systems, future on capacities as well as recent technologies to bridge the gap.

Post lunch Mr HR Dash, General Manager - Major projects,

**BPCL** spoke on 'Contract Management: Issues and Challenges' at Pre-Award Contract stage and Post Contract Award Stage. Effective conceptualisation, effective planning, proper documentation, adherence to Quality, HSE standards, allowing no cost overruns were some of the success factors highlighted through his wellstructured presentation.

Biju Mathews, Chief Supply Chain Officer - Chemicals, Fashion Yarn & Insulators Business of Aditya Birla group then shared on SCM Challenges in the Chemical business. Using well-structured PPTs, Mr Mathews highlighted SCM challenges in transport industry like complexity in transportation and how it amplifies global disruptions in supply chain and, potential solutions like continuous risk analysis near shoring or off shoring, global multi modal transport.

Panel discussion on 'Procurement in a Globalized World 'was led by Mr Bala Iver with panellists - Mr. Sathia Raj CPO, Sr. President, Ultratech Cement Ltd, Ms. Seema Mohanty Global Supplier Manager Bayer India, Mr. Sandeep Karkare, Head Direct Materials Procurement & Licence, Engineering Contracts RIL and Mr. Rupchand Lohana, Head Offshore Analytics group, Central Digital SCM, L&T Energy Hydrocarbon and Offshore. Some of the issues discussed were technical procurement vs under license procurement, IPR rights, procurement of project material, standardisation and supplier collaboration and digital solutions like collaborative platforms.

High tea with snacks followed technical sessions. This was specifically arranged to facilitate networking opportunity to participants and speakers.











Technical Sessions on Day 2 - 28/11/24

Day 2 began with 'Awakening' corporate kirtan, by Mr Sameer Limaye, Motivational speaker, staunch follower of Ramdas Swami. Drawing upon shlokas from Das Bodh and his previous corporate experience, Mr Limaye enthralled the audience into full belief of 3 key words, Shavan, Manan, Satatya for self-growth. One of the shlokas, rhymes with IIMM ethos,' Swayam sikh-kar sikhave, vahi Shresth pad pave. Lok jo ulzakar rah jave, Unhe Vivek bal se Sulzaye.

Followed by Mr. R. Veeraraghavan, Head Strategic Sourcing, FES,M&M Ltd spoke on 'Strategic Sourcing: Beyond Resilience' to share on how resilience is being built at Mahindra's supply chain .Through simple but well-structured presentation, Mr Veeraraghavan shared some of major initiatives towards supplier risk assessment, risk management and its mitigation, on all parameters of operations like Fire, safety, Finance etc. over and above global disruptions, through structured

reporting mechanism like BRSR, EPR, QCO(quality control order), ESG, DSA etc.

Next was Mr. R L Bharadwaj, Head of Procurement Research Centre, Arun Jaitley National Institute of Financial Management on Public Procurement Reforms. He gave very crisp and self-explanatory presentations on reforms in procurement systems, especially Gem portal.

Ms. Abanti Sankaranarayanan, Chief Public Affairs Officer and Member of the Group Executive Board of M &M Ltd presented on Building sustainability & ESG with vendor, highlighting various initiatives under implementation / monitoring at Mahindra's for addressing all issues like greenhouse gases, water scarcity, pollution, land mis use, waste disposal, reduction in resource /material use in addition to use of more &more sustainable energy towards plant positive.

Bridging the Talent Gap was next session by Dr Sanjay Deshmukh, former vice chancellor, adjunct professor at Mumbai University. The Presentation based on his research was highly informative and could be useful for skill gap analysis. Dr Deshmukh has graciously agreed to share his research report with IIMM and the delegates attending Disha 2024.

Next up, Mr Jaykumar, Executive, Indian Foundation for Quality Management, gave a thought-provoking presentation on 'Getting India Inc. Quality standards to Global Benchmark'. He showed that India's export share has remained fairly stable at lowly 1-1.6%. For 'make in India' to take off India incorp has to not only elevate quality standards, but also to market it, like what Japan, Germany etc did with their JUSE, ASQ, or EFQM. IFQM has been founded by industry leaders like Tata Sons, TVS Motor Company, Sun Pharma, Biocon etc. to fill up

Mr. Harsh Mallya, Senior Vice President P&C, RIL enlightened on Procurement of Services and associated Challenges. Some of growth challenges to service industry, as per him are infrastructure, cyber security, Technology, and shortfall of skilled manpower.

Concluding session on Global logistics was by Mr Pavithran M Kallada, Director of BDP logistics, when he expounded on various challenges to shipping logistics industry, like constant unpredictability due to shipping capacity fluctuations and possible solutions like 'Friends shoring' or creating collaborations across board.

During the event, Disha 2024 Souvenir was unveiled which has 8 articles from immensely knowledgeable authors and practitioners. Also, IIMM Mumbai Chairman launched the Research survey on 'Future Competencies in Supply Chain' which will enable professionals and companies to know the future trends in skill development and also, create learning opportunities for practitioners.

Such megaevent calls for astute anchoring. Surendra Deodhar did it brilliantly in his inimitable and eloquent style engaging the audience as well as introducing the speakers.

Finally, there were two lucky draws with prizes galore. First Lucky draw was for the delegates who visited exhibition booths, with lucky delegates from each Booth winning cash prizes. Second lucky draw was open to all registered participants with five lucky participants getting cash awards.
