PART - C**[Total: 20 Marks]****Q.10****CASE STUDY (Compulsory)**

M/s Storage Systems Limited (SSL) were small time transporters and had a small warehouse for the temporary storage of goods. Sensing the dramatic increase for 3 PL service providers M/s SSL decided to identify and enter this market. One of the main activities of a 3PL operator is the efficient operation of the warehouse. This needed a proper design for efficient operation. They identified a consultant to help them set-up the warehouse.

The first step identified by the consultant was to decide on the location of the warehouse and the costs associated with it. Once this exercise was completed, the major factor that will influence the warehouse operation is the product mix. The ease of operation and warehouse design is greatly influenced by the product mix. Additional factors that influence the design of the warehouse were studied in detail. Each of these factors are essential design factors to be considered for all warehouses irrespective of the type of material. these design factors are part of the activities carried out by the warehouse and hence influence the design of the warehouse. Additional infrastructure related to the material handling equipment is required for the smooth operation within the warehouse. Each category of material handling equipment has its own role to play in the warehouse.
